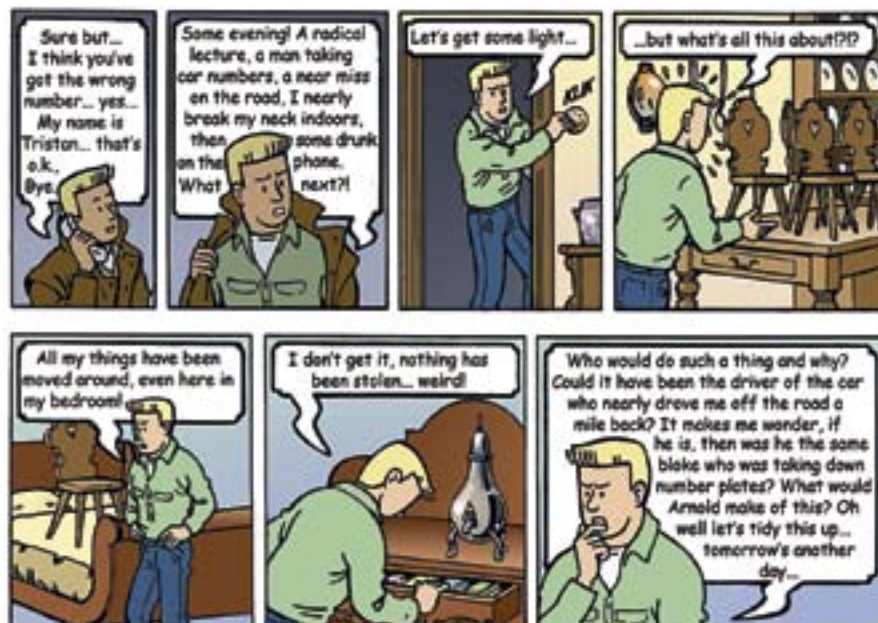


Penny farthings thrill crowds at Evandale
